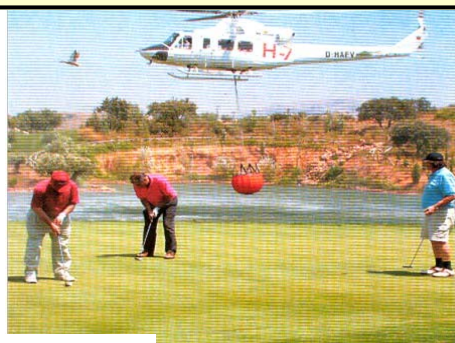
CAPTAIN'S Letter:

DIAGNOSING the SLICE

'Quick Tips' by: Roger Gunn
GRIP—Your hand or hands, especially your left hand, may be turned too far to the left. The 'V' formed between the knuckle & thumb on both

hands should point between your right shoulder and right ear. **SET UP:** The shoulders and/or the feet are often aligned too far to the left of the target line. **BALL POSITION:**

The ball might be placed too forward in your stance. **BACKSWING:** You may be taking the club back too far to the outside, pushing the club away from you. This often goes along with the club 'laying off' (pointing left) at the top. Additionally, there can be a clockwise twisting of the club during the downswing.

DOWNSWING: Your right shoulder might be going too much out & not enough down. The arms are often pushed away from you at the transition, causing the club to approach the ball from outside the target line. There can also be blocking of the wrists through impact, preventing the club from turning over.
