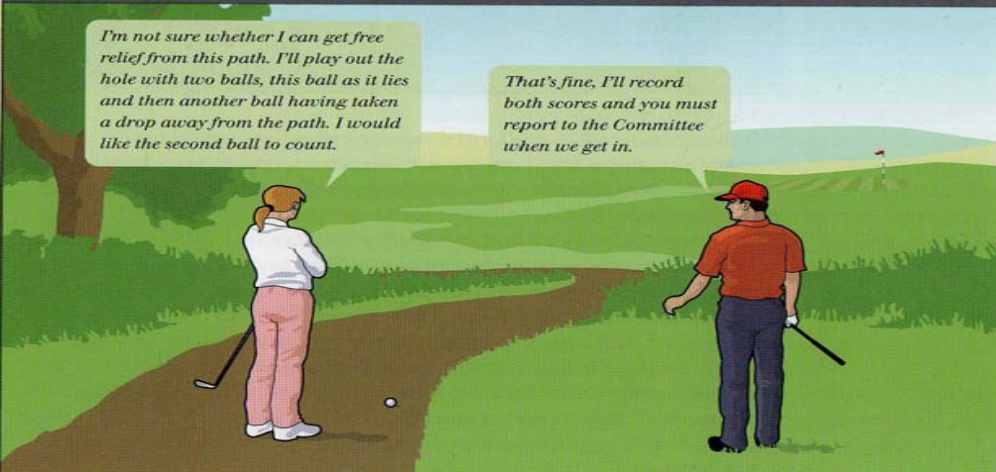
Welcome to the June Newsletter and Results. This is the last issue before the Summer recess and the last in it's current format.
