

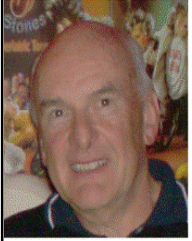

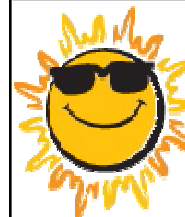

So along with Liz and eight friends, we started at the Round bar in Calle Gloria. A huge range of tapas on display to satisfy all tastes. We shared a few stories with the remnants of the Swiss fans who had seen their team loose to Spain. Next we moved to 'La Piscina' which is situated a short distance away in Calle Cruz (entrance to the main underground car park) We were welcomed warmly by the Spanish landlady who quickly served up beers and tapas. I was intrigued to find out why the bar was called 'La Piscina', as there was no sign of any swimming pool. She explained that there used to be a pool at the rear of the bar, but had been compulsory purchased to make way for the new underground car park!!



Then we were off to Calle Cristo (Post Office St) calling in at 'El Pulguilla' where despite it's stainless steel décor, we received another warm welcome. There were at least a dozen different tapas, ranging from morcilla to mejillones and all freshly grilled as you wait.

Our next bar was one that Malcolm visited on his tapas run, 'La Taberna' also in Calle Cristo. We were not disappointed! Excellent tapas, big helpings, good red wine and extremely friendly. There is also a large alcove inside to the left!! Our



final tapas bar 'Taberna de Pepe Moles' on Calle Anton Millon was also excellent. It is a fairly new bar and it could become a gem amongst so many very good tapas bars, that we are lucky to have here in Nerja!
