Captain's Letter!



Firstly I would like to thank and congratulate Derek on his splendid newsletter of which I have been asked to contribute. My theme this year will be the rules of golf (R&A) As most of you that have played golf with me know, that I am a bit of a stickler for

the rules and etiquette come to that Most times I play I get asked, "what do I do here?" or there is a discussion in the bar about a rule. A common query is "dropping the ball" How many club lengths? The general rule is, if it is without penalty, it is ONE club length from clear relief, not nearer the hole. If it is with a penalty, it is TWO club lengths from where the unplayable LIES, or in the case of hazard TWO club lengths from the line of the hazard. Incidentally when dropping the ball it may roll up to two club lengths from where it first struck the ground, not nearer the hole than its original position. Of course there is normally more options to be considered when dropping, one of them is you can always go back to where you last played the stroke.

Whilst talking of rules, I would like to ask those of you going back to the UK or Ireland, to try and obtain copies of the rule book (normally free at golf clubs) Let me have them and I will distribute them to those members over here without one. Thank you & happy golfing, your captain Jim Emery.

Did You Know???

In competition, during gunfire or While bombs are falling, players may take cover without penalty for ceasing play. The positions of known delayed action bombs are marked by red flags at a reasonable, but not guaranteed, safe distance there from.

A ball moved by enemy action may be replaced. Or if lost or destroyed, a ball may be dropped no nearer the hole, without penalty. A player whose stroke is affected by the simultaneous explosion of a bomb may play another ball from the same place. **Penalty:** 1 stroke. Taken from: "Temporary Rules 1940" Richmond Golf Club.)
