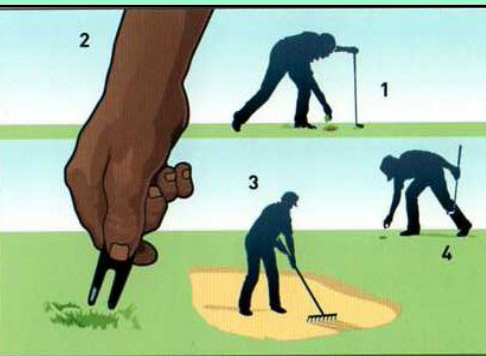
I look forward to meeting and working closely with the new Committee, to discuss and expand new ideas for the future.
