As the draws have to be made a few days ahead and unforeseen changes can occur, the need to **be at the course half an hour before you play** is an obligation as, occasionally, you may be moved one tee-time earlier, or two tee times later. It is hoped that this scenario will not happen too frequently, and where possible would affect a different player each time.

Notice / Display Boards

Whilst it will take a little time to be fully operational, tee-times will be displayed at various sites. Dream Properties have agreed to display in their window in Nerja. Axarquia Golf are offering a display within their premises, and telephone enquiries for tee-times will also be widely available during trading hours. This option will apply to all members as notice boards will carry information, irrespective of courses.

Newsletter

The Newsletter will contain all relevant information regularly, so effectively it can serve two purposes; a reference point for future activity and a record of the previous month's achievements. All course Rep's numbers will be a permanent fixture of the Newsletter.
