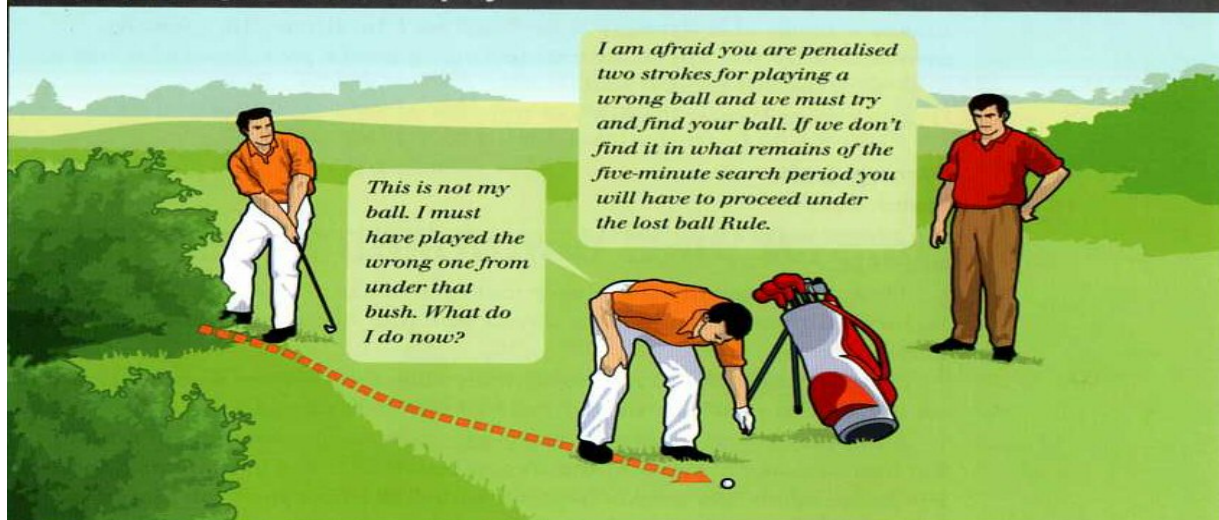

EUROPEAN/AUSTRALASIA TOUR: Michael Hill New Zealand Open

England's Richard Finch strolled home to his first ever win on the European Tour with a comfortable 3 shot victory over Australian's Paul Sheehan and Steven Bowditch. Finch had started the final round with a 3 shot lead and as his nearest competitors struggled, Finch increased his lead to 6 with 9 holes to play. Finch was never in trouble after that and when he rolled in his 12 foot par putt on the 18th green he had finished on 14 under-par 274 and claimed a three shot victory and his first winner's cheque.

SUNSHINE TOUR: Nedbank Golf Challenge

South African Trevor Immelman edged out England's Justin Rose by a single shot in an enthralling encounter during the final round. Rose moved 2 clear of Immelman early on, but the young South African clawed his way back and then took the lead when Rose made a poor bogey at the 13th hole. Immelman saw his chance and

quickly moved 2 clear when he pitched in for birdie at the 14th. Both players then parred the 15th, before Immelman's game left him. A bogey at the 16th and 17th holes meant the pair were again tied for the lead. With nerves showing Immelman made his third straight bogey at the 18th, but that was good enough as Rose some how contrived to make double bogey to hand Immelman a 1 stroke victory with a 16 under-par 272 total.

EUROPEAN CHALLENGE TOUR: Abierto del Litoral Personal 2007

Argentina's Miguel Rodriguez and Andres Romero battled back and forth all through the final round with each player holding the lead at certain points early on in the round. Rodriguez regained his one shot lead with a birdie at the 15th, but then double bogied the 16th to give Romero the lead once more. Rodriguez was not done and a great birdie at the 17th drew him level once

more. Down the 18th they both went, but this time it was Romero who made the mistake. A bogey 6 on the par 5 handed Rodriguez, who parred the last, the title by 1 shot with a 9 under-par 271 total.
