## El Ultimo Valderrama



Last March Bob Ilsley, Jim Paton and I answered an ad in the Daily Mail asking for marshals at the Andalucian Open. We all went along, enjoyed it and as a result were accepted to do the same at **The Volvo Masters at Valderrama 2008.**

Valderrama turned out to be an altogether grander affair. Most of the marshals seemed to have been doing it for years and were regulars at other events run by Barry and Mavis Drew who have a company which recruits and organises marshals at PGA tour events, mainly in the UK, such as the various opens and the Ryder Cup. Each volunteer is kitted out in a uniform which for this was provided by Peak Performance and consisted of an all important red rain jacket (229 Euros in the pro shop), two tee shirts, a belt, a cap and an umbrella which in my case did not last the second day's rain and wind. We also received a voucher for 120 Euros which could be used in the pro shop or for a reduced green fee round which I shall be taking at the end of the month. We also had 100 Euros of food vouchers which luckily was more than enough to cover some pretty respectable dishes in the tented village unlike at the Andalucian Open where we ate in the caddies' tent which was very average. It is your responsibility to be there at your appointed time which will depend on your hole and provide your own accommodation if necessary. Each marshal is given a hole for the 4 days which is run by a team leader who allocates locations and beefs up support if necessary. The group hold back any crowds, control crossings, ball spots and generally makes sure that life is made as easy as possible for the players and as enjoyable as possible for the onlookers. I was on the 3<sup>rd</sup> – a shortish par 3 which proved surprisingly tricky for the players especially when the weather was bad. Once all the players have passed your hole you are free to wander round and watch as you want.

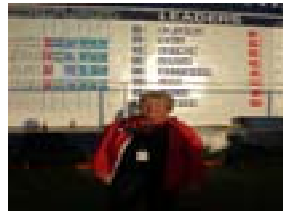
On the pro-am day you can volunteer to ball spot for a given group which I enjoyed as you have a chance to see the whole course although Lee Westwood's amateurs kept "his angels" very busy in the long grass and the bushes. Would I do it again? Without a doubt - and I have already put my name down for the Andalucian Open, which has been confirmed for 28<sup>th</sup> March, 2009. In spite of some of the worst weather they have ever had we saw some



of the best golf and pros at very close quarters. We know that even they will swear in bad conditions, that they can throw their clubs at trees to the point where they buckle, that they regularly miss "gimnee" putts (only one birdie on our hole on one of the days), that they will play the rules to the ultimate (plugging and standing water – what water?) and can be very "po" faced if they do not have the rulings they want (hanging around for a draw which the sponsors were keen to have and placing the ball on a course that stood up to the weather amazingly well). We have been inside the

ropes chatting to the likes of the Westwoods to hear that he and Darren Clarke are selling their plane because it is proving too expensive and that Lee Westwood is back in Sheffield this week having his tonsils out. So if any of this strikes a chord then there is a good chance that you can marshal at the Andalucian Open next year which will probably be at Aloha again though that has to be confirmed. Jim, Bob and I can give you the low down and Mavis and Barry have said that they are looking for more marshals there and will be more than happy to hear from anyone in GINS on [barry.drew@tesco.net](mailto:barry.drew@tesco.net) Just make sure you keep the Monday free for the courtesy round of golf still set to Sunday pins and the excellent buffet in the clubhouse which more than made up for the slop in the caddies' tent.

## Sponsorship by GINS Members.....

*Did you know that GINS operates a scheme to promote private sponsorship by its members?*

*It does and this is how it works:*

GINS has a system of assisting sponsorship by its members, it is based on the numbers playing on the day. It can be 1€ per player to a maximum of 50% of the €150 allowance for the day for full sponsorship. If you happen to sponsor a day that has a very large contingent, then the 50% maximum would be 75€. A second option is that at anytime you can elect to sponsor the first prizes for Ladies and Gents, then GINS will supply the remaining prizes. With the 1st prize scheme you would be advised of its value by the course representative who will establish the amount based on the numbers playing, and the split between men and women competitors.



## Membership Notice

**With immediate effect the GINS committee has set the joining fee to cover administration costs at €40,**  
**The Annual Membership fee remains unchanged at €50.**  
**The Annual Membership fee for NEW MEMBERS ONLY shall be a pro rata amount based on unexpired months.**  
*(This will allow GINS to attract new members during the low golf season here in Spain)*  
**In discussion with prospective members it may be pointed out that their outlay can be recovered by the GINS discounted golf rates at various courses. An official handicap should accompany a new members application form. Three cards must be processed by the handicap secretary before new members can win prizes.**  
**The committee retains the right to fully refund the joining and membership fee of new members if appropriate grounds to do so are established.**

you who weren't at this year's AGM, and some who were, may have little or no clue as to the whys and wherefores of how your handicap is arrived at.

### Competition Standard Scratch

was introduced to try to even out handicap changes and to take account of playing conditions on any particular day. I think that this has been fairly successful but there are some difficulties particularly where there are insufficient numbers (less than 10) to apply the formulae provided by the Golf Unions. I can always discuss any questions you have in the Puente most Saturdays or on 662059077. New members are required to submit 3 cards before they can win a GINS prize. These cards are **not** used to calculate handicaps unless you don't already have a club or society handicap. Your GINS handicap will be considered lapsed if you haven't played in over 12 months and the Committee have decided that 1 new card should be submitted to reactivate your handicap and make you eligible for prizes. Requests for handicap increases following illness, injury or operation will be considered sympathetically; speak to me or any course rep. **Clear as mud?"**
