Professor W. H. Anker *Our resident golf psychologist, answers your golfing problems.*

Dear Prof, I am a 59yr old 22 handi capper and the biggest problem I have is that I hit the ball a pitifully short distance. I would like to occasionally reach the fairway from the tee. How can I hit the ball further? *John from Torrox Costa.* PROF replies:

There are many ways to hit the ball further, which involve complicated concepts like leverage, swing plane and so on, but I have learned through trial and experience that there are two easy ways to hit the ball further:

1. Hit it harder.
2. Hit it and then immediately run backwards.
